

In particular, be aware of other vehicles in the carparks at the deer shed, and sale shed. Keep children close at all times.


Do not enter pens with any animals, ask Andrew if you would like stags moved around for better viewing.



Altrive 262-21 was used as a 2yr sire for our 2024 mating. At 7.5kg he had plenty of grunt. At 3yrs he produced 9.46kg of very tidy velvet and he is a very big bodied, charismatic stag. We are keeping him for our breeding program. By prophet son ALT 80-15, 2nd place national velvet awards that we sold at auction for \$75,000 in 2019. The prophet was supreme champion in 2013. This stag has four other embryo brothers which cut 5.6, 5.75,6.10 and 6.90kg at 2yrs.

Dam 67-17 was used as a donor in 2021, and we have used her daughter 172-19 as a donor as well. Her grand dam is our top hind 82-14 who is breeding phenomenally for Altrive.

He had a beam of 25 and 26cm, and both sides had 25cm beam above the trez. The prophet, 10.54kg was supreme champion in 2013. Dam 44-11 only had the one son and a daughter, and unfortunately we sold her before we knew how good 80-15 was!



Corona belongs to Lindsay Tayles, and is a large framed and big bodied stag, very casual in behaviour and cut a very good 13.2kg of velvet at 5yrs in 2021. He passed away post rut in 2024.

At four years he cut 10.82 and claimed second place in the National Velvet Competition in 2020, behind Lazarus and only 0.63 of a point separated first and second.




Glaisnock (142-17) 11.2kg @ 4yrs,

His ET brothers are our sire 145-17 (deceased), 148-17 7.9kg @ 3yr, 186-17 8.6kg @ 3yr and 162-17 7.8kg @ 3yr all sold in the 2021 sale.. 82-14 has 8 sons that have reached sale age, and 7 of these have been sold at auction or retained for sire duties at Altrive. The only one not being sold at auction cut 10.85kg so was also no slouch!

We will get a second opinion from an independent Vet prior to sale. Murphy's law at play here, we couldn't believe it was a stag of this calibre! We think you can look past this, and see the breeding and really beaut, tidy velvet he is producing. His beam measurements are fantastic at 25/27 and 24/28.

153-17 produced this son to AI in 2021 and we used her as a donor in 2024. Her dam 82-14 from our top dam line, which has produced over 20 sale stags for Altrive.

The combination of our top hind over Tayles Corona, we think he should breed on well.
